A new 85,000 SF elementary school is being constructed at 15<sup>th</sup> & Allen Streets, adjacent to the existing Jackson Elementary School. The Allentown School District acquired three adjacent parcels to accommodate construction of the new facility. Designed by Roberson Butz Architects, it will accommodate 750 students and is organized into three distinct masses. Each mass is composed of multiple “learning communities” for each grade level.

Exterior materials include brick, concrete block, aluminum curtainwall and storefront systems, and glazed brick accents.

The new Jackson Elementary School will be LEED-certified through the U.S. Green Building Council. The project will have sustainable features such as green roofs, reduction of existing impervious areas, native plantings, exterior sunshades, energy efficient mechanical and lighting systems, water-efficient plumbing fixtures, recycled/regional materials, abundant day lighting and curriculum enrichment opportunities for students.
